- Please upload the slides prior lecture, not just 10min before but a day at least (so we can print out/prepare/etc.)
- Assignments are far too difficult
- The idea of doing an assignment is good, but it should be easier. Because now everyone just copy the code from last year and did not learn as much.
- Sebastian has a difficult task this semester. We didn't learn anything about RMarkdown or how to deal with large amounts of data etc. in previous courses, thus the first assignment was at first a punch in the face. The



moment, when Sebastian introduced how he builds up a r-project and how he build up rmarkdown, was the key to our assignment's success. But this knowledge has to be given in one of the first lectures or in the data sourcing lecture. In conclusion, my recommendation: We have to learn EVERYTHING we need for this assignment (not the content, but how to built up such codes and the environment in R) previously (how does RMarkdown work, that there should be a 1_datasourcing, 2_dataprocessing 3_output file etc.) But I really liked is that we actually did something in R, that we coded and did something "credible". Thus this lecture is a MUST in the schedule

- remarks about assignment: - lecturer said to put someone in each group with experience in R, I didn't have such a person in my group twice while other groups had several. In itself this is fine, but than don't say you will do it differently. - We were asked to work with Markdown, even though we had never used or learned about this before. This required a lot (!!!) of work, which was completely not out of balance with the amount of credits. Similarly, the programming itself. Other courses could make the preperation way more easy. - Very knowledgable lecturer, but tends to be a bit fast in the lecture, I would recommend him to (especially for more complicated topics) go a bit slower.

Ich hatte nicht das Gefühl das der Dozent daran interessiert war, dass jeder einzelne den Inhalt der Veranstaltung tatsächlich versteht.*
- The course was interesting, as wel as de bespoken topics. Level of the course was not fair to the foreign (Non-Liechtenstein) bachelor programs. Strong need in Statistics and Mathematics is necessary and is not provided by uni for these basics. Assumption of Bachelor is wrong!! Last but not least: Unfortunate Dr. Stöckl wasn't able to answer questions in a polite way!
- Regarding the assigments: I suppose you do these assignments every winter semester. Why is it so enormous difficult to create one COMPLETE task sheet? if you want that we recreate the paper then state this in the assignment-task! It is senseless to note that we should use "x/y" lags, instead refer to the paper (at least mention that we should recreate it!). If the university is not able to replace the original R-instructor (and provide him with the necessary topics he should teach), then they have to lower the requirements for the other courses. Threat students with more respect. If the Uni Liechtenstein is not possible to bring everyone on one level, then they should not complain if students ask certain topics.
- The lecturer is very competent but should take remarks of the students more seriously. It doesn't help anybody if you ask a question and feel like you're not being taken seriously just because the lecturer is on a very high level. Also as useful as the assignment might be (they were actually quite fun and I feel like I learned important skills), writing it in markdown seems like the most pointless thing to me. After graduating, most of us will never use this again. Also, for just 3 Credits, using markdown and spending hours and hours to fix stuff, that can be done in Word in one hour, does not seem appropriate to me.

 - The starting Level was way too high. Better communication between courses necessary and pre-maths-course before the start of the first semester necessary to know what to prepare before starting the courses.
 - The course is interesting but way to theoretical and I'm sure that I will not need this stuff outside of school ever again. But I understand that this is stuff that is relevant for an Msc Finance Curriculum so I guess it's okay. The lecturer is extremely competent but could take students a little more seriously. :-)
 - Lecturer should be more respectful with the students. He speaks too fast to note everthing down. Please slow down next time! It would be great if we could apply some of the models via R!
 - The teacher is very known in his field of study, but only in his field! The way something has to be taught is also important!!! Almost nobody had a good base in Econometrics, but Dr. Stockl assumed that we are here from bachelors of University Liechtenstein and didn't gave us the basics for Econometrics. Very dissapointing. Some questions (by some people) are always answered postivly were others are answered in a rude matter. We are here to learn and become proffessionals in our field, facilitate that!
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
